

## **Child and Family Science Minor**

### **(2016-Current)**

*The Child and Family Science minor is a minimum of 21 units (7 classes),  
of which minimum 9 units must be upper-division.  
A grade of C or better is required in all minor courses.*

Take these three classes:

- CFS 31 – Families in America (GE 4B/formerly D2)
- CFS 39 – Introduction to Child Development (Lifelong Understanding & Self-Development/formerly GE E)
- CFS 153 – Developmental Research

Complete 12 units in CFS electives (consult advisor for approval):

- CFS 134 – Multicultural Perspectives on Children and Families (Multicultural)
- CFS 135 – Parenting Education

- COUN 150 or CFS 150 – Laws Relating to Children
