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## Advising Notes

1. ANTH 161 may not be taken to satisfy an elective for Biophysical/Forensic emphasis students.
2. ANTH 118 and ANTH 117 can satisfy the cultural or biophysical elective requirement.
3. ANTH 30 does not satisfy elective requirements in the major.
4. Certain ANTH G.E., W, and MI courses can be double counted with major requirements, including ANTH 2, 3, 161 (except biophysical students), 105W, 116W, 125, 128, 120.
5. ANTH 130 can satisfy either the cultural or archaeology elective requirement. ANTH 118 and 117 temporarily may count towards a biocultural elective requirement or a cultural elective requirement.
6. Students who opt to complete a Certificate can drop one elective requirement from their area of emphasis.
7. Use the COSS advising center to help you track your progress to graduation. Use your anthropology faculty advisors to support major course selection, internships, graduate school and career exploration and preparation.
