**The Ball Dreams of the Sky** is a poetic memoir written in the language of baseball. Henry Schipper is an award-winning Los Angeles-based filmmaker who has written and produced over 125 primetime documentaries for Netflix, History Channel, and National Geographic (among others). He once held the Babe Ruth League record for consecutive no-hitters in Wisconsin. He is the author of Broken Record, a social and cultural history of the Grammy Awards, and has written extensively on culture and the arts for The Hollywood Reporter, Daily Variety, Rolling Stone, Ms. Magazine, Mother Jones, USA Today, and other publications. His parents were Holocaust survivors. **The Ball Dreams of the Sky** is his first book of poetry. It was nominated for the Casey Award for the best book about baseball in 2025.
